Floyd, a Labradoodle, started with us as a wee pup. And now he is a 'man'!!! Never a wallflower around here. He is normally the center of any and all activity.

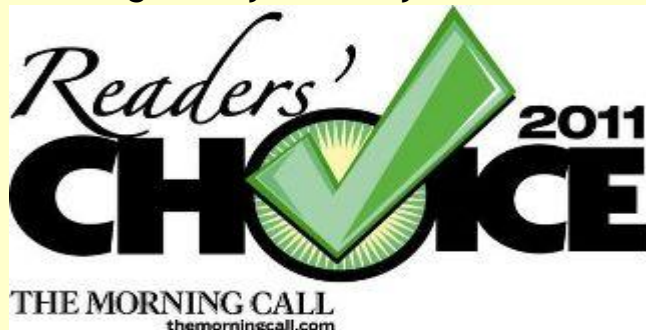
Jett, a Poodle Mix, started at The Puppy Palace very timid. Besides dancing to West Side Story show tunes, he is the engine of the running train on any given day.
